- The school shall admit in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to the weaker section and the disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion:

Provided, that in case of pre primary cases also, this norm shall be followed.

- 4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per sub-section 2 of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursement, the school shall provide a separate bank account.
- The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any Screening Procedure.
